YEAH Mission Statement

Is a support group for any home educated you in grades 5 through post high school graduation, regardless of religious belief, political persuasion, or ethnic background. It is run by its members, with an active board of directors, to provide youth an opportunity to learn leadership skills as well as have input into the activities. YEAH holds to a Christian world view and value system. All youth attending YEAH activities will be expected to follow ethical and moral guidelines implicit in these values.

YEAH Board members and hosts reserve the right to ask anyone attending a YEAH sponsored event to leave that activity if their attire, behavior, and/or speech is deemed inappropriate. Based on the judgment of the YEAH Board members present at that activity. Parents will be called if needed to pick up their youth.
